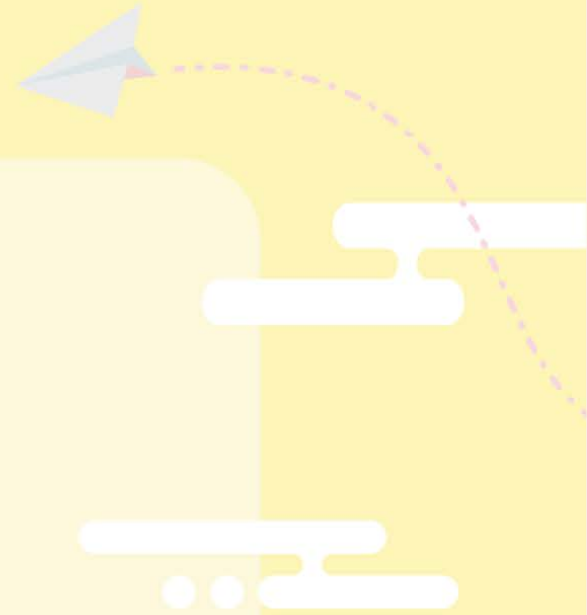

Nursery 2 Term 4 Snapshots

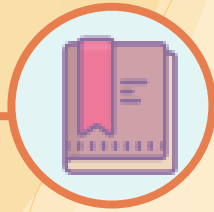
This is what your child would have learnt by the end of this term!



Term Overview

Our focus for this term was on the following themes:

- water sports and activities
- food and dining
- being at the airport



Reading

This term, your child was introduced to **10 word families** and learnt how to **read new words**. Your child also **practised identifying 13 common sight words**. These skills are essential in **promoting confidence for early readers** and **enhances reading speed and fluency**.



Continued Learning at Home

To reinforce what your child has learnt in class, they:

- received specially designed boards, cards, stickers and short stories to **revise the different word families learnt**
- **practised identifying the sight words they learnt** with a swimming-themed die

Term Overview

In Term 1, our focus will be on the following careers:

- meteorologist
- chef
- musician



Three Presentations through Role-Play

To help your child **pronounce their words clearly**, we will practise **vocal projection exercises** together before each presentation.



Reading

To **develop your child's reading skills**, we will:

- review the letters of **the alphabet**
- introduce them to **middle vowel sounds** and **consonant blends**
- **expose them to different text types**, including a weather report and a recipe



Continued Learning at Home

To **reinforce what they will learn in class**, your child will receive:

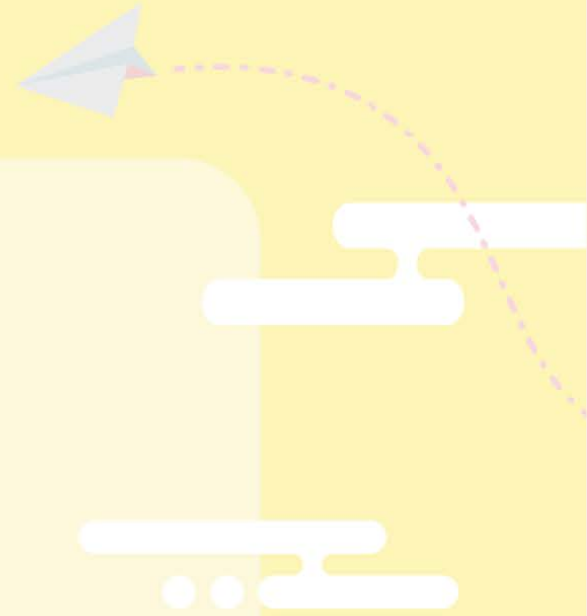
- a weather wheel to **revise different weather conditions**

Nursery 2 Snapshots of Term 4

This is what we have learnt so far!

We reinforced number concepts through our **weekly Number Mastery series**, where we revisited number recognition and number word recognition for numbers up to 20. We began **exposure to solving word problems**, to help with your child's transition to Kindergarten 1 (K1).

Your child built on and expanded their knowledge on topics such as **Time, Numbers, Measurement, Addition and Subtraction** with activities in class. For addition, your child tossed double-sided counters and found the total number of different coloured counters by forming addition sentences. Your child also explored the concept of 'o'clock' for the topic of Time, by turning the hour hand of a given clock.

We made learning fun and relatable through our **coloured thematic revision booklet** every 3 to 4 weeks during revision cycles to reinforce previous weeks' concepts. Your child **prepared for an imaginary overseas trip at the airport, played games at a carnival and celebrated a graduation party**, all while revising math concepts learnt in this term.





Kindergarten 1 Highlights of Term 1

This is what you can look forward to next term!

As your child progresses to K1, they will enhance their foundational math skills and expand their mathematical knowledge through **a structured learning journey**. Each week, your child will focus on a specific topic, practise number sense, and take a quiz in the following lesson to reinforce key concepts. With structured worksheets and various practice questions, your child will **develop discipline in learning and gain confidence in problem-solving**.

For this term, your child will learn topics such as **Shapes, Patterns, Spatial Sense and Mass**. For number sense, **addition within 10** will be introduced using pictorial aids and number lines.

Similar to Nursery 2, learning will be made relatable and fun through hands-on activities, exciting games as well as making connections to daily life.

To make learning fun and engaging, we tap on **story-based activities** such as locating different animal enclosures on a map whilst learning about rows and columns. For Christmas, your child will get a chance to design a party hat using their own colour pattern creation!
