Topics covered

To help your child **master singular and plural nouns**, we will give out a **specially designed grammar revision booklet** that will be used alongside the grammar module. This booklet will include practices that allow your child to apply what they have learnt.



Skills learnt

We taught your child how to **make their writing stand out by describing emotions using the show-not-tell technique**, and **phrases and idioms that are related to colours**.

Skills learnt

Children should be curious about their world! To **increase your child's appreciation of the natural wonders of the world**, he or she will learn the necessary **content and presentation skills** to share about a natural wonder they would like to visit with their family members.



Highlights

Through a colourful visual worksheet, we will teach your child **body-related adjectives and verbs** that can be used to **build up their vocabulary** and help your child **express specific actions or descriptions in their writing**.

Primary 1 Mathematics

Term 4 Snapshots

Topic(s) covered

- **One new topic, Money** – Your child learnt to solve word problems involving the three operations – addition, subtraction and multiplication. In a **board game, 'Cash Quest'**, your child got the chance to practise on everyday money transactions.
- **Early headstart to next year's curriculum** - selected **new Primary 2 topics** were introduced during the school holiday period (Multiplication, Division, Geometry, Shapes and Patterns)

Skill(s) learnt

- Your child learnt to use **model drawing** to solve **repeated identity word problems** involving addition and subtraction.
- Your child was also exposed to **two different methods of working backwards** – to use either a diagram or to form an equation to solve word problems.



Highlights

- Your child **applied concepts learnt** in the topic **Money** and **Multiplication** to help Ruby the Rabbit plan her lunch expenditure for a week.
- Your child **revisited concepts** through **topical revisions, a story-based booklet and the concept kit activities.**



Primary 2 Mathematics

Term 1 What to expect

Topic(s) covered

- **What to expect for P2 curriculum** – On top of learning new topics **Fractions** and **Volume**, your child will expand their knowledge of Primary 1 topics, dealing with bigger numbers and more complex word problems.
- **Laying a strong foundation** – We will build on the **fundamentals for Numbers to 1 000, Addition and Subtraction** to prepare your child for the arithmetic skills needed for word problems.

Skill(s) learnt

- **Exposure to more word problems** - your child will further develop their existing Primary 1 knowledge, such as model drawing and working backwards techniques, to solve more complex word problems.



Highlights

- **Starting the new level with a story** – Using an interesting storyline, your child will be introduced to new Primary 2 Measurement and Fractions concepts as a data collecting zoologist.
- Ruby the Rabbit returns with a **Rescue Mission**, where your child will get to revise concepts learnt through a **story-based booklet.**
